UNIVERSITY CALENDAR FOR 1994-95 REVISION #2

On February 25, 1993 the Faculty Senate referred Academic Standards and Calendar Committee Report #1992-93-1A: Revised University Calendar for 1994-95 back to the Academic Standards and Calendar Committee for reconsideration.

The Academic Standards and Calendar Committee met on Tuesday, March 30 ,1993 to reconsider the proposed calendar based upon the advice of the Faculty Senate. The Committee is now presenting a revised 1994-95 University Calendar for consideration by the Faculty Senate.

With regard to the 1994-95 Calendar, the Academic Standards and Calendar Committee recommends approval of the following motions:

1. That for the 1994-95 academic year the Faculty Senate grant an exception to section 8.70.22 of the UNIVERSITY MANUAL to permit the scheduling of one week-day reading day after the last day of classes.

Section 8.70.22 of the UNIVERSITY MANUAL reads as follows:

8.70.22 A minimum of two week-day reading days will be scheduled after the last day of classes.

2. That the Faculty Senate approve the proposed University Calendar for 1994-95 (Revision #2).
