FACULTY SENATE RESEARCH POLICY AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE GRADUATE COUNCIL

JOINT REPORT ON SPONSORED RESEARCH April 1993

On February 25, 1993, the Faculty Senate referred to the Research Policy and Facilities Committee (REPOFAC) drafts of new sections 10.49.10-11 proposed to be added to the UNIVERSITY MANUAL. These proposed sections were originally submitted to the Senate by the Graduate Council.

The Research Policy and Facilities Committee considered the proposed UNIVERSITY MANUAL changes at its meetings of March 22 and 29, 1993. After consultations with the Dean of the Graduate School, Vice Provost for Research, and the Executive Director of the URI Foundation, REPOFAC approved the proposed revised sections <u>10.49.10-11</u> for submission to the Faculty Senate.

On April 2, 1993, the Graduate Council voted to accept the wording of sections <u>10.49.10-11</u> approved by the REPOFAC on March 29, 1993 and to forward these sections to the Faculty Senate.

Therefore, the Research Policy and Facilities Committee and the Graduate Council jointly recommend at this time that the Faculty Senate approve the following new sections of the UNIVERSITY MANUAL:

<u>10.49.10</u> Sponsored Research. Scholarly activity supported wholly or in part by third parties is hereby defined as sponsored research for the purposes of section 10.49.11.

10.49.11. Graduate Students Engaged in Sponsored Research. The Dean of the Graduate School is the only person authorized to approve those terms in any agreement with third parties that place restrictions on graduate students engaged in sponsored research. The University will not honor any such agreements made without authorized approval, and parties to such unapproved agreements will consequently assume any and all resultant liabilities as individuals.
