**REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE  
November 1, 1996**

On October 17, 1996, the Faculty Senate Executive Committee reviewed the proposed Scheduling Policy recommended by the Athletics Advisory Board and agreed that it should be forwarded to the Faculty Senate. At a subsequent meeting, held on October 29, 1996, the Executive Committee agreed to recommend that the proposed Scheduling Policy be approved by the Faculty Senate.

**SCHEDULING POLICY**

**Recommended by the Athletics Advisory Board  
October, 1996**

Intercollegiate athletic contests at the University of Rhode Island will not be scheduled (at home or away) during either the final exam period or designated reading days.

Issues regarding Conference championships and special tournaments not controlled through University scheduling that occur during the final exam period will be forwarded to the Athletics Advisory Board for their recommendation to waive the above policy and permit participation. The board's recommendation will be forwarded to the University President for final action.

During the final exam period compulsory practice sessions will not be scheduled.
