At the November 21 and December 12, 1997 meetings of the University College and General Education Committee, the following matters related to the current General Education Program were considered and are now presented to the Faculty Senate for confirmation.

The UCGE Committee recommends the approval of the following additions to the current General Education Program proposed by the College of Arts and Sciences:

1. That HIS 328 The Holocaust (I or II, 3) be assigned into the Letters (L) area.
2. That the following Physics courses be assigned into the Natural Sciences (N) area:
 - a. PHY 203 Elementary Physics I (I and II, 3);
 - b. PHY 204 Elementary Physics II (I and II, 3);
 - c. PHY 205 Elementary Physics III (I and II, 3);
 - d. PHY 273, 274, 275 Elementary Physics Laboratory I, II, III, (I and II, 1 each).
