



I. Matters Requiring Confirmation by the Faculty Senate

A. College of Engineering

1. Add (New)

CHE 503 Dynamics of Chemical Engineering Applications (I, 3)
Emphasizes analytical and/or numerical techniques commonly used in analysis arising from classical chemical engineering applications, and necessary for understanding more complex problems. Rivero-Hudec

B. Graduate School of Oceanography

1. Add (New)

OCG 533 Graduate Writing in Marine and Environmental Sciences (I, 3) Graduate writing in marine and environmental sciences; writing and editing journal articles and abstracts; principles and practice in scientific writing. Pre: Graduate standing and WRT 101, or permission of instructor. Rahn
