On October 28, 2004, the Faculty Senate approved the following amendment to Section $\underline{4.22}$ of the Faculty Senate By-Laws which had been introduced at the September 23 Faculty Senate meeting:

That section <u>4.22</u> of the By-Laws of the Faculty be amended by adding "the Vice President for Student Affairs or designee" to the list of *ex officio* members of the Academic Standards and Calendar Committee.

The revised section 4.22 of the By-Laws would read as follows:

<u>4.22</u> The Director of Enrollment Services or designee, the Vice President for Student Affairs or designee, and the University Ombud shall serve as *ex officio* members of this committee.
