

**Revised Proposed Calendar for 2011-12**

At the February 23 meeting of the Faculty Senate, the Academic Standards and Calendar Committee Report #2005-006-3: Proposed Calendar for 2011-2012 was referred back to committee. The Academic Standards and Calendar Committee met on March 1, 2006 and proposes a revised calendar as follows,

- Fall semester Advising Day comes after Labor Day
- Fall classes begin on Sept. 7
- Classes are canceled on both Columbus Day and Veteran's Day
- The end of classes is extended from Dec. 9 to Dec. 12, and Friday classes are scheduled for Dec. 12 (a Monday)
