



University College and General Education Committee Report #2009-10-4

On November 5, 2009 and December 3, 2009, the University College and General Education Committee approved the following matters, which require confirmation by the Faculty Senate.

I. English Communication (EC) Core Area

The UCGE Committee recommends that the Faculty Senate approve COM 108 (or ECN 108 or SUS 108) Spaceship Earth: An Introduction to Systems for the English Communication (EC) core area of the General Education program:

II. Fine Arts and Literature (A) Core Area

The UCGE Committee recommends that the Faculty Senate approve the FAL 151 (or LET 151) Topics in Fine Arts and Literature Topic: “Jewish American Literature and Culture from “The Great Tide” of Immigration (1881-1924) to the Present” for the Fine Arts and Literature (A) core area of the General Education program:

- c. **WRT 240 The Essay** (*reading complex texts, examining human differences, using information technology*) Diversity

IV. Natural Sciences (N) Core Area

The UCGE Committee recommends that the Faculty Senate approve the following courses for the Natural Sciences Core (N) core area of the General Education program:

- a. **NFS 210 Applied General Nutrition** (*reading complex texts, using quantitative data, using information technology*)
- b. **PHP 143 (or NUR 143 or PLS 143) Sustainable Solutions for Global Health Problems** (*speaking effectively, using information technology, examining human differences*) Diversity

V. Social Sciences (S) Core Area

The UCGE Committee recommends that the Faculty Senate approve the following courses for the Social Sciences (S) core area of the General Education program:

- a. **COM 108 (or ECN 108 or SUS 108) Spaceship Earth: An Introduction to Systems** (*writing effectively, speaking effectively, using quantitative data*)
- b. **PHP 114 (or NUR 114) Responsible Health Care** (*writing effectively, speaking effectively, using information technology, examining human differences*) Diversity
- c. **PHP 143 (or NUR 143 or PLS 143) Sustainable Solutions for Global Health Problems** (*speaking effectively, using information technology, examining human differences*) Diversity
