

At meeting No. 451 held 31 January 2011, the Graduate Council considered and approved the following curricular matters which are now submitted to the Faculty Senate for information or confirmation as indicated.

I. 500/600-level courses

Changes:

ENG 595 Master's Project – change in credits from 1-6 to 3 and a change in catalog description to read: Student produces MA portfolio in consultation with major professor and committee. S/U only.

ENG 599 Master's Thesis Research– change in credits from 1-6 to 3 and a change in catalog description to read: Student produces MA thesis in consultation with major professor and committee. (Independent Study) S/U credit.
