

Academic Standards and Calendar Committee
Report #2016-17-2

Following the discussion by the faculty at the November 17, 2016 meeting of the Faculty Senate, the Academic Standards and Calendar Committee has undergone a detailed review of all the existing academic calendars starting from AY 14-15 through AY 21-22. The Committee paid close attention to the precedent set by the University for each holiday and special events when reviewing the AY 22-23 calendar.

During the review of the calendars, several errors were identified that require editorial changes. These include:

Fall 2020

1. Editorial changes to correct the days on the following dates: Wednesday 10/21, Wednesday 11/11, Friday 12/11, and Monday 12/14.
2. Editorial change to have offices closed (not open) on Election Day.

Fall 2021

1. Editorial change to have offices open (not closed) on Election Day.

Spring 2022

1. Editorial change to correct the day on March 25. It should be Friday (3/25) not Wednesday.
2. Editorial change to correct the dates listed for Reading days. It should be May 4 not May 3-4 (May 3rd had already been designated as "Reading day or class make-up day if needed" in the previous line).

The Committee also reviewed and approved the following changes to the University Manual as it relates to the summer calendar.

Existing 8.70.11 The calendar for the Summer Session shall be developed by the Feinstein College of Continuing Education, in consultation with the Office of Enrollment Services, and submitted to the Academic Standards and Calendar Committee by March 1 of the preceding year. The Academic Standards and Calendar Committee shall submit the summer-session calendar for approval to the Faculty Senate by April 1 of the preceding year. [#01-02-27](#)

Proposed 8.70.11 A six-year ~~The~~ calendar for the Summer Session shall be maintained. The ~~developed by the Alan Shawn Feinstein College of Continuing Education, in consultation with the~~ Office of Enrollment Services ~~in consultation with Summer Sessions~~, each fall shall prepare a new sixth-year calendar and submit it ~~, and submitted~~ to the Academic Standards and Calendar Committee by ~~the end of October. March 1 of the preceding year.~~ The Academic Standards and

Calendar Committee shall submit the ~~summer session~~ calendar ~~for approval~~ to the Faculty Senate by ~~December 1. April 1 of the preceding year.~~

Rationale: Change the summer session calendar from a 2-year to a 6-year calendar to better align with the 6-year academic calendar (fall, winter, and spring semesters). Update to reflect the change in responsibility from the former Alan Shawn Feinstein College of Continuing Education to Summer Sessions in the Provost's Office. Minor editorial changes have also been made to maintain consistency with language used in paragraph relating to the academic year calendar (8.70.10). These changes were reviewed and approved by Enrollment Services.

The Committee reviewed and approved the following calendars for summer sessions SM18-SM22.
