

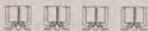


.. PROLOGUE ..

The toilers, from the sowers even to the gleaners and millers, have all lent their honest effort to the cause. May their labors be appreciated and criticism, however just, be lenient.

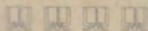


.. PROLOGUE ..
